PURPOSE:

To disseminate a new Consolidated Community Reporting System (CCRS) instruction manual for the Office of Mental Retardation.

BACKGROUND:

The CCRS was created in 1980 and last updated in 1987. Since that time, program definitions and reporting needs have changed. This revision will bring the reporting up-to-date while requiring minimal changes in data systems.

APPLICATION:

Attached for your immediate use are the revised instructions for the CCRS. They are effective for reporting for the current Fiscal Year (1996-1997).

All CCRS reports are now annual; that is, reports need to be submitted only at the end of the fiscal year. Mid-year reports are no longer necessary.

The Early Intervention (MR255) portion of the CCRS has been eliminated. All data for Early Intervention will be taken from the Early Intervention Reporting System (EIRS).

Every attempt has been made to standardize age groups and definitions both in the report and with other MR reports.
