Abstract:

File transfer protocol (FTP) is

“... the protocol used for copying files to and from remote computer systems on a network using TCP/IP, such as a dedicated circuit. This protocol also allows users to use FTP commands to work with files, such as listing files and directories on the remote system. See also TCP/IP. 2. A common logon ID for anonymous FTP.

To download files from or upload files to remote computer systems, via the Internet's File Transfer Protocol. The user needs an FTP client to transfer files to and from the remote system, which must have an FTP server. Generally, the user also needs to establish an account on the remote system to FTP files.”

General:

The purpose of this document is to provide the standard regarding file transfer at the Department of Human Services (DHS).

Standard:

Use of the FTP protocol is restricted to internal data transfers to/from the UNISYS mainframes within DHS. All other networked host systems are required to COPY files to SeGOV-Staging area as defined by the SeGOV team. File transfers to locations outside of the DHS network will be controlled through dedicated secure Managed File Transfer servers as separately described in departmental Data Exchange Standard and related documentation.

At this time DHS supports IPSwitch enterprise Managed File Transfer software. The preferred method of transfer is over the Internet. This meets data transfer requirements as set for in OA Information Technology Bulletin SEC0031-Encryption Standards for Data in Transit.
