CHIPRA Quality Demonstration Grant (a.k.a. QUICKSTEPS)

- Five-year CMS Grant Awarded from 2010-2015
- Total Award: \$9,794,571
- Three Categories:
 - Category A – Testing and Reporting on the Pediatric Measures of Quality
 - Category B – Promoting the Use of HIT in Children’s Healthcare Delivery
 - Category D – Demonstrating the Impact of the CMS Pediatric Electronic Health Record Model Format

Category A

- Pediatric Quality Measures
 - Total Practice Sites: 64
 - Flat File Specs Completed on 11 of the 24 Measures
 - 15 Measures will be Electronically Extracted and Reported by June 2011
- PA Dept. of Health Statewide Immunization Registry
 - Geisinger to Connect April/May 2011
 - CHOP to Connect the End of May 2011
 - Category D Health Systems to Connect by Fall 2011


Category B

- Pre-clinic Visit Screening Tools Focus on Five Specific Domains:
 - Developmental Delay
 - ADHD/Disruptive Behavior
 - Adolescent Suicide/Depression
 - Autism Spectrum Disorders
 - Maternal Depression Screening
- Special Health Care Needs Children
 - Focus on Coordination of Care and Medication Management for Children with Complex Medical Conditions
- PELICAN/HCSIS
 - Early Intervention Care Plan Access for Medical Personnel

Category D

- Five Health Systems to Test the CMS Pediatric Electronic Health Record Model Format
- Westat's Preliminary Model Format
 - Includes 434 Elements
 - Covers Areas From General EHR Functionality to Child Specific Needs
- Testing of the Model Format will take place July-November 2011
